Our Feb cover shows the antenna mast for 2m repeater VK6REX at Exmouth Gulf, and a view from the platform 30 feet from the mast's top. Seriously, VK6REX is sited on Tower Zero at the joint Australia — US Naval Communications Station Harold E Holt near Northwest Cape. At a height of 1,275 feet (389m) it is the highest repeater antenna on a man-made structure in Australia.
